## Biographical Information

John Douglas Fair was born September 6, 1943, in Waynesboro, Pennsylvania. He received his B.A. degree in History from Juniata College, Huntingdon, Pennsylvania in 1965. The following year (1966] at Wake Forest University, Winston-Salem, North Carolina, Fair earned his M.A. degree in History. In 1969 he received his Ph.D. degree in History from Duke University, Durham, North Carolina.

John D. Fair served as an instructor in the History Departments of York College of Pennsylvania (York, Pennsylvania, 1967) and Millersville State College (Millersville, Pennsylvania 1968). He continued his teaching services as an Assistant Professor of History at Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, Blackburg, Virginia from 1969 to 1971. Dr. Fair came to Auburn University at Montgomery, Montgomery, Alabama as an Assistant Professor of history in 1971; he became an Associate Professor in 1975, and a full Professor in 1981. During 1981 Fair was Visiting Professor of History, University of Maine at Orono, Orono, Maine. In 1989 Dr. John Douglas Fair was appointed Departmental Head for the History Department of AUM.

## Scope and Contents

This collection contains the rough and final drafts for the books The AUM Story: A decade of service to the Montgomery community vol. I and vol. II (Brown Printing Company). Included are handwritten first drafts, interview transcriptions and typed/printed revisions of the manuscript. Also included are the author's research materials containing university and other publications.

The collection offers some interesting insights into the creative research and writing process of a book. The material provides documentation of Dr. John Fair's interpretation of the past as well as a chronicle of the growth and expansion of a relatively young institution. The score of years covered by the Fair papers (1969 to 1989) provides detailed and general views of university expansion through the inclusion of financial and annual reports from university offices. ### **SERIES DESCRIPTION**

#### Series 1. Series I: Organizations and Associations, 1970-1997

This Series contains documents pertaining to conferences that Dr. Fair attended and/or presented papers. The conferences include: American Committee for Irish Studies, North American Society for Sporting History, Radical Right in Western Europe, Southern Conference on British Studies, Weightlifting Associations, and Western Conference on British Studies. The files are arranged in alphabetical/chronological order.

#### Series II : Personal Papers, 1986-1997

This Series contains personal correspondence to and from Dr. Fair, ranging in years from 1986-1997. The documents are in reference to the following people and/or organizations and are arranged in alphabetical/chronological order: Articles pertaining to: Shelby Foote,

SERIES 3. Vol. I AUM Story: Research materials and drafts.

Folder(s): 1

Research notes and textual drafts find miscellaneous placement throughout the folder.

Notes pertaining to various subjects and disassociated text completes the majority of the papers contained within this series. Manuscript portions take the form of handwritten and typed/printed drafts. Occasional notes on printing format, statistics, and institution/university publications appear.

Folders: 2-16

Arranged numerically by chapter with text divided into subsections occurring in alphabetical order. Succeeding chapter placement, complete drafts appear in chronological order beginning with Complete First Draft (A) and concluding with Final Revision (B). Chancellor's comments are interspersed between first and second drafts.

Handwritten and typed/printed chapters occur in corresponding chapter files. Corrections appear directly on the text itself either in the author's hand or a select colleague's. Numerous autographed notes signed appear free and attached to the related manuscript sections. Corrected subsections for drafts are present.

Vol. II AUM Story: Research materials. Folders: 17-30

Arranged numerically according to chapter, these folders contain the notes, statistics, and publications utilized by the author. Included among the scholarly elements of preparation are scattered *annual* reports from university departments and organizations. Biographies, student affairs summaries, and general consideration of events during the decade of scrutiny, find deliberate placement in the text.

Series IV: Scholarly Works/Books: British Constitutional Conferences, and Harold Temperley

This Series is contains drafts and completed versions of both manuscripts along with research notes and materials pertaining to each book. Document files pertaining to "British Constitutional Conferences" are arranged by preliminary abstracts, research notes, drafts of each chapter in chronological order, revisions, loose ends and permission letters. Document files pertaining to "Harold Temperley" are arranged by Correspondence, drafts for each chapter, then Misc. documents, permission letters, and ending with research notes for each chapter.

Series V: Scholarly Works/Papers & Presentations

This Series contains documents pertaining to papers and presentations prepared and/or given by Dr. Fair. The files are arranged alphabetically, papers being listed first, followed by presentations.

Series VI: Scholarly Works/Reviews

This Series contains reviews that Dr. Fair wrote for various books submitted for his review by the author or publisher. The document files are arranged alphabetically and include handwritten notes, typed notes and, in some instances, letters from the publisher or author.
